Rebate Checklist

Get your rebate faster by checking off the following steps before submitting your application form. Complete and accurate applications mean fewer delays in processing your rebate check.

- Purchase a qualifying electric bicycle (eBike)
- Attest that you have read the Income-Qualified Eligibility requirements and attach proof of enrollment or participation in one of the eligible assistance programs listed in the Terms and Conditions
- Attach copies of receipt, invoice, or other proof of purchase clearly detailing the final purchase price after any point-of-sale discounts, rebates, and/or tax credits
- Review Terms and Conditions and completely fill out application
- Make and retain copies of all documents and application

Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for the rebate, you must:

1. Be a residential Black Hills Energy electric customer, 18-years or older, with an account in good standing. Must also live in a residence that receives electric service from Black Hills Energy.
2. Purchase a qualifying battery electric bicycle between January 1, 2026 and December 31, 2026. Rebate application must be received by Black Hills Energy on or before December 31, 2026 to qualify for the rebate.
3. Meet income-qualified requirements as defined in Income-Qualified Eligibility section in the Terms and Conditions, as determined by Black Hills Energy.

Failure to meet any of the foregoing requirements may result in denial of the rebate.

Terms and Conditions

Black Hills Colorado Electric, LLC (“Black Hills Energy”) is offering this limited time electric bicycle rebate (“eBike Rebate”) to qualified Black Hills Energy customers purchasing a qualifying electric bicycle (“eBike”).

By signing and submitting this application for the eBike Rebate, the Black Hills Energy customer submitting this form: (1) acknowledges that such individual is the account holder whose premise address appears above; (2) acknowledges and certifies the information in this application is accurate and complete; and (3) agrees to be bound by the terms and conditions herein.

Income-Qualified Eligibility

Income qualified customers must provide proof of participation or enrollment in at least one of the following assistance programs: Colorado’s Low-income Energy Assistance Program (“LEAP”); Energy Outreach Colorado’s Affordable Residential Energy Program (“CARE”); Colorado’s Weatherization Assistance Program (“WAP”); Black Hills Energy income-qualified Demand Side Management (“DSM”) program; Black Hills Energy’s income-qualified Community Solar Gardens; Black Hills Energy Affordability Program (“BHEAP”); any other Black Hills Energy program for income-qualified customers; Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (“SNAP”); Temporary Assistance for Needy Families program (“TANF”); Colorado Energy Office’s Community Access to Electric Bicycles Rebate Program, or Colorado Energy Office’s Vehicle Exchange Colorado (“VXC”) Program, subject to verification.

Qualifying Electric Bicycles (eBikes)

The applicant must purchase a new electric bicycle (eBike) meeting the following criteria:

Must meet independent UL certification standards. The eBike must be certified to UL 2849, UL 2271, or EN 15194. eBikes that are UL-certified typically have a UL certification logo on the bike battery. Must be a new eBike purchased from a participating bike shop/retailer. Used eBikes are not eligible. Must have an electric motor that is 750 watts or less and must not be gasoline powered. Must have two or three wheels and fully operable pedals. May be any class of eBike (per the State of Colorado eBike definition). Includes: Class 1: an electrical assisted bicycle equipped with a motor that provides assistance only when the rider is pedaling and that ceases to provide assistance when the bicycle reaches a speed of 20 mph. Class 2: an electrical assisted bicycle equipped with a motor that provides assistance regardless of whether the rider is pedaling but ceases to provide assistance when the bicycle reaches a speed of 20 mph. Class 3: an electrical assisted bicycle equipped with a motor that provides assistance only when the rider is pedaling and that ceases to provide assistance when the bicycle reaches a speed of 28 mph. May be an adaptive eBike. No minimum purchase price; no maximum purchase price.

Rebate Availability and Limitations

Black Hills Energy offers a limited number of eBike Rebates paid out on a first come, first served basis. Rebates are limited to one (1) person 18-years or older, per year with a total limit of four (4) rebates per household, per year. Availability is subject to total number of program participants. Black Hills Energy reserves the right to cancel or modify this eBike Rebate program at any time in its sole discretion. Black Hills Energy makes no representations or warranties regarding whether you will or will not qualify to receive the eBike Rebate.

By submitting this application, the applicant acknowledges and understands that if any of the information provided is discovered to be false, applicant agrees to pay back any rebate amounts paid by Black Hills Energy. Any information provided in this application may be used internally by Black Hills Energy for purposes other than processing the application and may be made available to the Colorado Public Utility Commission (“PUC”). All personal information will be handled in accordance with applicable laws, PUC rules and regulations, and Black Hills Energy’s privacy policy.

The applicant is responsible for adhering to all laws, rules, and regulations related to the applicant’s purchase and use of the eBike and is responsible for paying all fees related to such purchase and use. The applicant is responsible for all tax liability imposed as a result of the eBike Rebate, if any. Black Hills Energy is not responsible for any taxes imposed on the applicant as a result of the eBike Rebate, if any.

Rebate Stack-ability With Other Incentive Programs

This rebate may be used in conjunction with other purchase rebate and/or tax credits and incentives programs as long as the total incentive amount does not exceed the purchase price of the bicycle. The applicant agrees to disclose all other incentives and rebates received both at the point of sale and post-sale. Applicant understands that the total rebate payment may be less than \$500 if it causes total incentives received to surpass the bicycle purchase price. If applicant fails to disclose any and all incentives received for the bicycle purchase, they understand this rebate payment may be revoked and they could be required to repay the amount back to Black Hills Energy.

Release and Indemnification

You agree to release, indemnify, and hold harmless Black Hills Energy, its affiliates, respective officers, directors, shareholders, and employees from and against any and all causes of action, damages, losses, claims, expenses, demands, and costs (including attorneys' fees), resulting from, arising out of, or in any way connected with the electric bicycle, eBike Rebate, or any taxes associated therewith. Black Hills Energy is not a party to any sales transaction between you and the seller of the electric bicycle. Black Hills Energy's liability and responsibility in connection with this program shall be strictly limited to the making of certain rebate payments for program-eligible electric bicycles, and Black Hills Energy does not make, will not provide, and specifically disclaims any and all representations, warranties, covenants, or guaranties whatsoever, express or implied, in connection with the electric bicycle and the income-qualified eBike Rebate program itself. Black Hills Energy shall in no way be liable or responsible for any electric bicycle purchase under the eBike Rebate program, or for any act or omission of any other entity or individual related thereto, including, without limitation, the electric bicycle manufacturer or any electric bicycle retailer or other service provider.

I hereby attest that I meet the Income-Qualified requirements for this rebate program and have provided the necessary supporting documentation as proof of my enrollment in at least one of the eligible assistance programs listed in the Terms and Conditions.
