The accompanying tariff sheet issued by Black Hills Colorado Electric, LLC, d/b/a Black Hills Energy (“Black Hills” or the “Company”) are sent to you for filing in compliance with Decision No. R22-0316 issued in Proceeding No. 21AL-0650E (the “Decision”), the requirements of the Public Utilities Law and the applicable rules of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of Colorado, including Rule 1210, 4 *Colorado Code of Regulations* 723-1. This filing is made in accordance with the Decision requiring an annual update of the Fixed Reasonable Charge applicable to Off-Site Net Metering Service. Included with this filing are Attachments A and B supporting the rate calculation update. The updated Fixed Reasonable Charge results in a rate of \$0.03170/kWh as compared to the existing rate of \$0.03187/kWh. The Company notes that no customers are participating in Off-Site Net Metering and the Company does not receive any revenues as a result of this rate. The Company notes that Colorado HB 26-1225 has passed the legislature which directs the Commission to set new limits on Off-Site Net Metering Facilities. Black Hills will await a Commission decision regarding new limits before updating tariff language.

Black Hills requests that the tariff sheet accompanying this advice letter become effective July 1, 2026.
